
Astrological Thesis Paper

The term "planets" is used here in the classical sense as "wandering stars". These include the Sun, Moon, \mathfrak{P} , \mathfrak{O} , \mathfrak{I} and \mathfrak{T} . In modern astrology, \mathfrak{S} and \mathfrak{P} as well the dwarf planet \mathfrak{Y} , are also included. In addition, according to Lips, the two astrological Higgs particles \mathfrak{Y} and \mathfrak{T} .

The planetary symbols are composed of a circle (sun), sickle (moon), cross [arrow] and dot. Except for \bigcirc and C, all have at least one cross [arrow] and a circle or a sickle.

 \bigcirc = circle and dot; C = sickle; \heartsuit = cross, circle and sickle; \heartsuit = cross and circle; \eth = arrow and circle; \eth = arrow, circle und dot; 4, 5 and \varPsi = cross and sickle.

That is why I prefer the Pluto symbol (Υ , cross and sickle) by Heinrich Kündig. It comes closest to the other planetary symbols. Also Υ (cross, sickle and "small" circle) could still be valid. Other common Pluto symbols are \ominus , o, o and \complement . \varUpsilon represents the first letters of **PL**uto and the initials of **P**ercival **L**owell, who spent years searching for a planet outside Neptune.

Although astronomers have agreed on the symbol \diamond (alchemical symbol for platinum), some astrologers still use a stylised **H** (\forall) for Uranus, referring to its discoverer [Friedrich] Wilhelm **H**erschel.

 \odot and C I call *Lights of Life* and 5 and 6, the two opponents of the *Lights of Life*, I call *Causal Forces*.

The thesis usually lists the *dualities'* RGB (RBG) poles before the CMY (CYM) poles. This "ordering scheme" is not meant to be judgmental.

Terms introduced by me are highlighted in *italics*.

Introduction

I was born on January 8, 1953 at 19:10 in Zurich, Switzerland. Before turning to astrology, I meditated intensively for two years (1971-1973) under the guidance of Indian yogis (Hatha, Mantra, Raja, Jnana and Karma Yoga), Zen masters, Christian mystics, and Sufi masters. As a result, boundless love and wisdom were unlocked within me. I knew that everything had to be symmetrical and perfectly ordered. I gained a totally non-judgemental view of things and the ability to look at cosmological relationships from a symmetry-based perspective.



The theses listed here result from intensive basic astrological research I have been conducting since 1974. The theses are not owed to any belief but to my inherent logic. They demand critical and active thinking from the reader. They are marked with the year in which they became self-evident to me. They shed light on the somewhat dusty classical astrology and provide a new, clear and deeper under-standing of the nature of astrological forces. And they answer a surprising number of religious, philosophical, astrological, and psychological questions.

Swim against the current if you want to reach the source

Most of these ideas are found in the **Thema Mundi**, the *Horoscope of the World*. Until 1990, my research focused on the dignity of the planets, accompanied by the practical application of astrology and extensive astrological, psychological and religious-philosophical studies. I wanted to find the universal symmetries underlying the classical and modern dignities and debilities. I considered the hitherto rather chaotic assignments to be the greatest weakness of astrology since it invokes cosmic and, thus, logically perfectly ordered forces. Even after they were established, I continued to examine and deepen them. Thus, the problem of domiciles and exaltations was settled in 1981.

I did not want to build on sand, therefore I deliberately did not elaborate on the meaning of the structures that I recognized in this system. Only when I no longer had any doubts that there was no simpler and more symmetrical explanation for the classical and modern domiciles and exaltations did I turn to the exploration of the structures contained therein in 1990. Soon the *Astrological Theory of Everything* crystallized the meaning and scope of which I have been investigating ever since.

The fact that I had to question, among other things, the trigonocracy, the four elements, the exaltations of the Sun and Saturn and recently even all the exaltations was never my intention and was accordingly difficult for me. My original adherence to what I had learned delayed my investigations for years. In addition, the belief that this complex world could not be structured so simply led me astray for seven years.

2008 Publication of the book "APOCATASTASIS - Astrological Vision of the Original Ground and the *Eternal Order of Creation*", Lulu Enterprises, Morrisville, NC 27560 USA, 2013, in which most of the theses listed here are substantiated in detail.

The twelve astrological planetary principles

- 1 From an astrological point of view, the cosmic forces and functions are reflected in twelve celestial bodies (planets). ^{1974/1995}
- 2 The astrological nature of these celestial bodies largely coincides with the nature of a zodiac sign. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 3 However, these celestial bodies are not "effectors" but only "indicators" of cosmic forces and functions. ^{1976/1995}
- 4 To date, we know ten of these indicators $(\bigcirc/C/\heartsuit/\diamondsuit/\diamondsuit/\diamondsuit/\diamondsuit/)$.¹⁹⁷⁴



- 5 Two other astrologically relevant celestial bodies are still unknown to us. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 6 They complete the *planetary dozen* and are of primary astrological importance. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 7 These two *astrological Higgs particles* orbit the sun outside of Pluto's orbit. ¹⁹⁷⁹
- 8 The closer to the sun is the passive counterpart of Venus. ^{1974/1979}
- I assign him to the Taurus and call him *Faunus*. ¹⁹⁷⁴
 His symbol [¥] is said to be reminiscent of the Taurus (♂) and the Moon (C). ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 10 The more distant from the sun is the passive counterpart of Mercury. ^{1974/1979}
- 11 I assign him to the Virgo and call him *Iustitia*. ¹⁹⁸²

At first, I called him *Minerva*, ¹⁹⁷⁴ but over time, the goddess Justitia, immortalised in the sky by Zeus as the constellation Virgo, crystallized out. ¹⁹⁸² Its symbol [5] is said to be reminiscent of the Virgo (\mathbb{T}) and the Saturn (5). ¹⁹⁷⁴

- For both, there must be a physical body in our solar system. ²⁰⁰⁸
 The provisional working names are borrowed from the Roman world of gods. ¹⁹⁷⁴
 Their character is derived from the sign they rule. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 13 Their positions should be determined astronomically and not astrologically! ¹⁹⁷⁴

Classical Astrology

14 Already in ancient times, people worked with *twelve planetary principles*. ¹⁹⁷⁴

The male \odot , the female C and the five planets $\Psi/\Psi/\sigma^2/4/5$ with one male and one female expression each.

15 We also encounter these *twelve planetary principles* in Chinese astrology. ¹⁹⁷⁶


The five androgynous pillars (planets) connect the feminine earth (moon) with the masculine sky (sun).



- 17 These *three originless, all-encompassing, universal dualities* have always been and will be forever. ²⁰²²
- 18 They have neither a beginning nor an end. ²⁰²²
- 19 Continuously following their nature, they are, shape and transform everything without intention. ²⁰²²
- 20 Apart from them, nothing is, never was and never will be anything. ²⁰²²
- 21 From them is formed the limitless variety of temporary and timeless states. ²⁰²²
- 22 These countless states appear in an infinite number of variations. ²⁰²²

The One (2^0)


- 23 The formula 2^1 , 2^2 , 2^3 of the *three dualities* leads us directly to 2^0 . ¹⁹⁹⁵
- From this, the Astrological *Theory of Everything* $(2^0, 2^1, 2^2, 2^3)$ can be derived. ¹⁹⁹⁵



- 25 The indivisible One (2^0) has neither properties nor form or shape, neither beginning nor course nor end.
- 26 As the unfathomable source of everything, the unsubstantial, nameless One could be called Non-Being.
- 27 The diversity is not outside the unity.

Movement, the first duality (2^1)


- 28 The twelve planets form six pairs, each with an extrovert and an introvert partner. The *first* duality can be derived from this. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 29 I call these partners *twin planets*. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 30 I call the duality derived from the classical duality of male-female *Movement* and its *two sides*, *Moving* [Red] and *Moved* [Cyan]. ¹⁹⁹⁵



- 31 *Moving* states are embodied by $\mathcal{Q}/\mathcal{Q}/\mathcal{A}/\mathcal{A}/\mathcal{O}$. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 32 *Moved* states are embodied by $C/5/\Psi/\Upsilon/\Upsilon/\Im$. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 33 Everything is in the *two states* of *Moving (active)* or *Moved (passive)*. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 34 Both partners stand for one and the same principle. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 35 They only differ in their orientation (extrovert-introvert). ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 36 4 is an extrovert Ψ and Ψ is an introvert 4, δ is an extrovert 5 and 5 is an introvert δ etc. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 37 Both partners form a unit and are harmoniously connected with each other. ¹⁹⁷⁶
- 38 *Movement* (2^2) is the first thing to appear. Not in the temporal sense, because it is without beginning and without end.


One could describe the *Movement* as an eternal, 🕉 similar vibrating hum.

- 39 *Movement* is closest to unity. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 40 This all-encompassing vibration is the root of all things. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 41 *Movement* (2^1) is the primary nature of everything. Everything is vibration. Everything is pulsation. ¹⁹⁹⁵



Substance, the second duality (2^2)

- 42 The twelve planets form six opposition pairs. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 43 I call this *duality* derived from the opposites *Substance* and its *two poles Soft* [Blue] and *Hard* [Yellow]. ¹⁹⁹⁵



- 44 Soft planets are $C/Q/4/\Psi/Y/\odot$. ^{1974/1995}
- 45 The *Soft* can assume *two states*, one *Moving* and one *Moved*. $\bigcirc/\bigcirc/\bigcirc$ are *Moving* and $C/\Psi/\curlyvee$ are *Moved*. ^{1974/1995}
- 46 Hard planets are $\frac{\varphi}{\delta}/\frac{5}{\delta}/\frac{1974}{1995}$.
- 47 The *Hard* can assume *two states*, one *Moving* and one *Moved*. $\delta/\Psi/\sigma$ are *Moving* and $5/\Psi/\sigma$ are *Moved*. 1974/1995
- 48 Everything is in a *Soft (vital)* or a *Hard (physical)* state. ^{1974/1995}
- 49 Two worlds (2^2) unfold from the Movement (2^1) and mirror each other in a contrary way. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 50 A vital (Soft) and a physical universe (Hard). ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 51 Both worlds have a *Moving* and a *Moved* side. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 52 Both partners are polar (contrary) to each other. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 53 They are in a tense relationship. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 54 They repel each other. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 55 Soft and Hard form two planetary families (clans). ¹⁹⁹⁵




Function, the third duality (2^3)

- 56 We get three planetary groups by combining the *first* and *second duality* (*twin* and opposition pairs). ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 57 The being-principles (O, C, 5, δ), the spiritual-principles (4, Ψ, Ϙ, 5) and the feeling-principles (9, Υ, σ', Υ) each form a group. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 58 The *being-principles* are a special group. ¹⁹⁷⁴



- 59 The spiritual-principles (Logos) and the feeling-principles (Eros) form the third duality. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 60 I call these *Functions* and their *two poles Logos* [green] and *Eros* [magenta].¹⁹⁹⁵



- 61 $\forall/4/\Psi/5$ stands for the *mental (Logos)*. ^{1974/1995}
- 62 *Mental Functions* occur in *four* states. A *Moving/Soft* (⁴), a *Moved /Soft* (^ψ), a *Moving/Hard* (^ϕ) and a Moved/Hard (^ਠ). ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 63 $Q/\sigma/\Upsilon/\Upsilon$ stands for the *energetic (Eros)*. ^{1974/1995}
- 64 Energetic Functions occur in four states. A Moving/Soft (♀), a Moved/Soft (♀), a Moving/Hard (♂) and a Moved/Hard (♀). ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 65 Everything is in a mental (Logos) or an energetic (Eros) state. ^{1974/1995}

Logos - Psychological


- 66 $\frac{1}{4}/\Psi$ stands for awareness, visions, imagination, trust, spirituality, optimism, Sense-making, dreams, intuitive and irrational consciousness, as well as. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 67 ²/₄ stands for creative consciousness, for pioneering visions, goal setting, foresight, prudence, reason, greatness, noblesse, magnanimity and synthesis. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 68 Ψ stand for ethics, faith, dream, fantasy, illusion, imagination, conceit, world view and the looking consciousness.¹⁹⁹⁵
- 69 Ψ/5 stand for order, control, atheism, intelligence, criticism, doubt, mathematics, causality, logic, purpose, pessimism, rational conclusions and the either-or. ¹⁹⁸²
- 70 ♀ stands for selection, decision, choice, analysis, investigation, decree, command, regulation, direction, examination, question, search, insight, research, and judgment. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 71 5 right, order, norm, principle, duty, precept, prohibition, rule, regulation, custom, precept, principle and taboo. ¹⁹⁸²

Eros – Psychological

- 72 φ/\forall stands for life, love, vitality, feelings, joy, aesthetics, peace, harmony, partnership, friendship, immortality, pleasure, beauty and peace. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- ⁷³ ♀ stands for creative vitality, friendliness, politeness, responsiveness, for cultural, artistic and aesthetic design and social coexistence.¹⁹⁹⁵
- 74 ¥ stands for living, contentment, the joy of life, happiness, satisfaction, fulfilment, cheerfulness, enjoyment and lust for life.¹⁹⁹⁵
- 75 σ'/¥ stands for power, self-assertion, energy, adventure, anger, confrontation, violence, egoism, combative and warlike impulses and the material.¹⁹⁹⁵
- 76 σ' stands for the use of force, attack, aggression, submission, fight, irritability, noise, ruckus, argument, riot, quarrel, action and assertiveness.¹⁹⁹⁵
- 77 ¥ stands for body-related, determination, tension, defense, perseverance, iron, relentlessness, resistance, coarseness, severity, indomitability, hardness and toughness.¹⁹⁹⁵

The four cosmic properties

- 78 The interaction of the second and third duality generates four cosmic properties. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 79 They can only exist at the same time and stand side by side on an equal footing. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 80 These I call; ²⁰²⁰



81 They each show themselves in a *Moving* and in a *Moved* form. ¹⁹⁹⁵

Third planetary group

- 82 With the *four planets of being* C/5/δ/☉ (*Lights of Life* and *Causal Forces*), *mental* and *energetic* forces are not yet separated. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 83 Here *Eros* (soul/body) and *Logos* (spirit/intelligence) are still one. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 84 That is why C/ $5/\delta$ / \odot stands out from the rest of the eight *planetary principles*. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 85 I call them *Tetrarchs*. ¹⁹⁹⁵



- 86 At this level, the Movement takes on four states. A Moving/Soft (☉), a Moved/Soft (C), a Moving/Hard (ð) and a Moved/Hard (5). ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 87 C/5/♂/○ deserve primary astrological attention. ¹⁹⁹⁵
 "The whole is greater than the sum of its parts!" Aristotle
- 88 The \bigcirc is the sum of $4 (\nearrow)$ and $\bigcirc (\simeq)$. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 89 Everything we can say about the Q and everything we can say about the A, we can also say about the O. ¹⁹⁹⁵

- 90 The C is the sum of Ψ (\mathfrak{X}) and Υ (\mathfrak{S}). ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 91 Everything we can say about Ψ and everything we can say about Ψ , we can also say about the C. ¹⁹⁹⁵

- 92 δ is the sum of $\mathfrak{P}(\Pi)$ and $\mathfrak{S}(\mathcal{V})$. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 93 Everything we can say about ♀ and everything we can say about ♂ we can also say about ♂ and nothing else. ¹⁹⁹⁵

Many $4/\Psi$ terms refer to visuals, such as insight, vision, illusion, imagination, fantasy, mirage, enlightenment, foresight, prudence, confidence, insight, worldview, view, intuition, dream, allegory, clarification, look, observation, flash, viewpoint, perspective etc.


97 Derived from $\mathfrak{P}/\mathfrak{F}$ (causal) and $\mathfrak{S}/\mathfrak{F}$ (forces), I call \mathfrak{S} and \mathfrak{F} Causal Forces. ²⁰⁰²

Sibling planets

98 The *Logos* and *Eros planets* form *four pairs*, which are harmoniously connected with each other. ¹⁹⁹⁵



- 99 I call the respective partner's *sibling planets*. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 100 $\xrightarrow{2}$ stands for the active (Moving) mental (Logos) and \bigcirc for the active (Moving) energetic (Eros) side of the Soft. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 101 \forall stands for the passive (Moved) mental (Logos) and \forall for the passive (Moved) energetic (Eros) side of the Soft. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 102 \heartsuit stands for the active (Moving) mental (Logos) and \circ for the active (Moving) energetic (Eros) side of the Hard. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 103 \Im stands for the passive (Moved) mental (Logos) and Υ for the passive (Moved) energetic (Eros) side of the Hard. ¹⁹⁹⁵



Structure of the twelve planetary principles

- 104 The twelve planetary principles are formed from the six poles of the three dualities. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 105 This allows the nature of the *twelve cosmic principles* to be described precisely. ¹⁹⁹⁵

106 C/ $5/\delta/\odot$ are each composed of one pole of the *two dualities of Movement* and *Substance*. ¹⁹⁹⁵

- 107 The Lights of Life (\bigcirc C) stand for the spiritual ($4/\Psi$) and vital ($9/\Psi$). ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 108 The \odot is always a *Moving*, *Soft* principle with *Logos* (*spiritual*) and *Eros* (*vital*) qualities. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 109 The C is always a Moved, Soft principle with Logos (spiritual) and Eros (vital) qualities. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 110 The Causal Forces (5) stand for the causal $(\frac{\varphi}{5})$ and physical $(\frac{\sigma}{4})$.¹⁹⁹⁵
- 111 & is always a Moving, Hard principle with Logos (causal) and Eros (physical) properties. 1995
- 112 5 is always a Moved, Hard principle with Logos (causal) and Eros (physical) properties. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 113 $\forall/\langle \varphi/\sigma'/\langle \psi/\psi'/\psi'/\rangle$ are each composed of one pole of the *three dualities* of *Movement*, *Substance* and *Function*. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 114 The *four Logos Functions* (Ψ/4/Ψ/5) have no emotional, physical, or energetic (*Eros*) properties.¹⁹⁹⁵
- 115 ⁴ is always a *Moving*, *Soft* and *Logos (spiritual)* principle. It embodies the Visionary and goalsetting. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 116 ¥ is always a *Moved*, *Soft*, *Logos* (*spiritual*) principle. It embodies consciousness.¹⁹⁹⁵
- 117 V is always a *Moving*, *Hard and Logos (causal)* principle. It embodies judging and deciding.
- 118 **5** is always a *Moved*, *Hard and Logos (causal)* principle. It embodies order and lawfulness.
- 119 The *four Eros Functions* (Q/O/Y/Y) have no mental qualities or consciousness parts (*logos*). 1995
- 120 🖓 is always a *Moving*, *Soft* and *Eros (vital)* principle. It embodies the development of life and love. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 121 F is always a *Moved*, *Soft* and *Eros* (*vital*) principle. It embodies the living.¹⁹⁹⁵
- 122 dis always a *Moving*, *Hard and Eros (physical)* principle. It embodies the unfolding of energy. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 123 ¥ is always a *Moved*, *Hard*, *Eros* (*physical*) principle. It embodies matter. ¹⁹⁹⁵

The double universe

124 This world formula $(2^0, 2^1, 2^2, 2^3)$ describes an equally large and powerful "contrary" mirrored *Vital Universe* in addition to the Physical Universe. ²⁰⁰²



- 125 Both worlds are strictly separated from each other. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 126 Both worlds have a *mental* and an *energetic* side. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 127 The mental side of the Vital Universe stands for the conscious and irrational. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 128 The mental side of the Physical Universe stands for lawfulness and logic. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 129 The *energetic* side of the *Vital Universe* stands for life and love. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 130 The *energetic* side of the Physical Universe stands for energy and mass. ¹⁹⁹⁵

Biospheres

- 131 The probability is very low that a Physical Universe will form where the natural constants are such that life can arise. ²⁰¹⁶
- 132 The fact that we still exist can only be explained today by divine providence or multiverses. $_{2016}$
- 133 If there were countless universes, they would all be based on the *Astrological Theory of Everything*. ²⁰¹⁶
- 134 Why? Because there is no simpler and, therefore, no more perfect formula (20, 21, 22, 23) that describes the fundamental properties of existence. ²⁰¹⁶

- 135 The existence of biospheres means that the *two polar worlds* touch at these points and that the *vital* mixes with the *physical*. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 136 Here the strict division between the two worlds is abolished. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 137 Biospheres are small islands in the cosmos that enable a symbiosis between the *vital* and *physical* worlds. ¹⁹⁹⁵



- 138 Measured by the size of the *two worlds*, the points of contact (biospheres/habitats) are infinitely small. ²⁰¹⁶
- 139 In universes where life is possible, there are countless points of contact (biospheres) between the *vital* and *physical worlds*. ²⁰¹⁶
- 140 All life forms are a mixture of the two opposing twin worlds. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 141 Both universes determine our lives. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 142 In everyday life, we use both worlds' mental abilities and powers. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 143 Countless small parts of the *Vital Universe* (entelechies, monads) are continuously incarnating in the biospheres. ²⁰⁰²
- 144 However, the Physical Universe terminates these life impulses after a relatively short time. 2002

Border areas

- 145 As the *vital/spiritual* flows into the *physical/causal* world, the *physical/causal* must also flow into the *vital/spiritual world*. ²⁰²⁰
- 146 I do not understand the Vital Universe as the so-called beyond. 2020
- 147 The beyond (*physicssphere*?) seems to be a counterpart of the physical biosphere in the *Vital* Universe. ²⁰²⁰
- 148 Just as the biosphere is embedded only in a small part of the *Physical World*, so the so-called beyond (with all its souls, spirits, angels, demons, gods, heavens and hells) is embedded only in a small part of the *Vital World*. ²⁰²⁰



- 149 One could also call the bio- and *physicsspheres subjectification spheres* because universal forces experience a temporary individualization here. ²⁰²¹
- 150 Since there is a practical astrology for the earth's biosphere, it is to be expected that every biosphere have a functioning astrology. ²⁰¹⁶
- 151 Also, in solar systems with two or more suns. ²⁰¹⁶
- 152 Thus, in a double star system, one sun could stand for the \odot and the other for the δ or the C etc. ²⁰¹⁶
- 153 The astrology of other biospheres would also have to depict the *three dualities*. ²⁰¹⁹

- 154 It would also have twelve (or eight) indicators (planetary principles). ²⁰²²
- 155 The arrangement of suns and planets as "indicators" of cosmic forces would have to be logical and symmetrical, as in our system. ²⁰¹⁶
- 156 The principle causing astrology works perfectly (see thesis 231). ²⁰¹⁶

Is astrology an "Easter Egg" of creation? ²⁰²¹

157 The eight psychological types of C. G. Jung correspond to the *eight Functions* derived from the *three dualities*. ¹⁹⁷⁶

- 166 The psychological types of C. G. Jung are in no way connected with the Elements of classical astrology. ¹⁹⁷⁶
- 167 Jung was too knowledgeable about astrology to have attributed introversion to the extroverted elements (fire and air) or extroversion to the introverted elements (water and earth).

According to J. H. Hoop, Jung found the eight psychological types empirically in his practical work. Did the I Ching also inspire him?

The two types of Manfred Curry



- 168 The two physically measurable types, Warm and Cold, discovered by Manfred Curry, correspond to the *duality* of *Soft* and *Hard*. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 169 Warm (Curry) = Soft (Lips)¹⁹⁷⁴
- 170 Cold (Curry) = Hard (Lips) 1974

His book "Der Schlüssel zum Leben" [The Key to the Life] gave me the first hint of the Soft and Hard polarity.

In it I had marked all the properties of his two types with the appropriate planetary symbol and thus quickly realised that I had labelled the Warm types with $O/C/Q/4/\Psi/Y$ and the Cold ones with $\Psi/\sigma/5/\delta/Y/S$.

- 171 The planetary colors can be derived from the *three dualities*. ²⁰⁰⁶
- 172 We can assign the three pairs of contrary colors, red cyan, blue yellow and green magenta to the *three dualities*. ²⁰⁰⁶




Graphical representation of the three dualities

I Ching (Chinese Astrology)

The eight planets $\mathfrak{P}, \mathfrak{P}, \mathfrak{I}, \mathfrak{P}, \mathfrak{I}, \mathfrak{P}, \mathfrak{I}, \mathfrak{P}$ and \mathfrak{I} form 28 (7x4) pairs with each other.¹⁹⁹⁵ 12 pairs are *friends*, 12 are enemies and 4 are *strangers*. ¹⁹⁹⁵

In the I Ching, these pairs are doubled. One distinguishes between Q/4 and 4/Q.¹⁹⁹⁵ In addition, the eight planets in the I Ching form eight pairs with themselves. ¹⁹⁹⁵

- 205 Chinese "astrologers" discovered the three dualities over 5,000 years ago. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 206 This later developed into the I Ching. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 207 Astrology seems to lend itself to getting to the bottom of the ultimate truth. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 208 In the traditional arrangement, the solid (-) and broken (--) lines are arranged uniformly in five sections and interchanged in one section. One simply overlooks the fact that the three levels each belong to a different duality. ¹⁹⁹⁵

- 212 This interchange also occurs in the two Dark Images, which is why ⊙=/==5 became the Old and Strong Yīn/Yáng and C==/==♂ became the Young and Weak Yīn/Yáng.¹⁹⁹⁵
- 213 Correct, however, would be $\bigcirc =/=C = Soft Y \bar{i}n / Y \acute{a}ng$ and $\circlearrowright =/== \circlearrowright = Hard Y \bar{i}n / Y \acute{a}ng$. ¹⁹⁹⁵
- 214 Because one only saw the duality Yīn/Yáng (light/dark) and ignored the other two dualities, one had to expand the original Tàijí Tú (€) with two points (€).¹⁹⁹⁵

Areas of knowledge

216 There are five major areas of knowledge. ²⁰¹⁹

1st - Astrological Theory of Everything (2⁰, 2¹, 2², 2³)

217 It is the subject of cosmology, astrological cosmology and mysticism (2^0) [and the I Ching]. 2021

2nd - Vital universe

218 It is approached from the fields of spirituality, religion, mysticism and metaphysics, among others. And would also be a subject area of biology and consciousness research. ²⁰²¹

<u>3rd - Space-Time Continuum</u>

219 It is the subject area of physics, astronomy, cosmology, astrophysics, mathematics, chemistry, geology etc. ²⁰²¹

Border areas

220 The biosphere is a platform from which to view the physical universe. The physicsphere is a platform from which to view the vital universe.



The "symbiosis" of the *vital* (*physicssphere* [beyond]) and *physical* (biosphere) *worlds* raises many questions.²⁰¹⁹

How are the two worlds intertwined? ²⁰¹⁶

How do they face each other (spatially, dimensionally, or otherwise)? ²⁰²¹

What is happening in both *border areas*? ²⁰¹⁶

What roles do the *energetic* (*vital/physical*) and *mental* (*spiritual/rational*) influences from both worlds play? ²⁰¹⁹

4th - Physicssphere


221 The *vital/spiritual borderland (physicssphere?* or afterlife) is, among other things, the subject area of religion, mythology, metaphysics, occultism, near-death experience, afterlife research, spiritualism, dream interpretation, parapsychology, shamanism, astral wandering, voodoo, huna, divination, witchcraft, PSI, New Age, esotericism, spirit conjuring, superstition, demonology, mantic and magic. ²⁰²¹

5th - Biosphere


222 The *physical/causal boundary* (biosphere) is a subject area of biology, medicine, ecology, paleontology, botany, microbiology, genetics, brain research, zoology, evolutionary theory, endocrinology, sociology, psychology and philosophy, among others. ²⁰²¹

Dignities and debilities of the planets

- 223 The essential dignities can be used in the tropical zodiac and in the sidereal zodiacs. ¹⁹⁷⁶
- 224 Personally, however, I think the tropical zodiac is correct. ²⁰¹⁰
- 225 The twelve planets have a dignity (domicile) or a debility (exile) in each zodiac sign. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 226 The *Soft planets* Moon Venus Jupiter Neptune *Faunus* and the Sun have their dignities (domiciles) in the *Soft zodiac signs* Taurus Cancer Leo Libra Sagittarius and Pisces
- 227 and in the *Hard signs* Aries Gemini Virgo Scorpio Capricorn and Aquarius, their debilities (Exile). ¹⁹⁸¹



- 228 The *Hard planets* Mercury Mars Saturn Uranus Pluto and *Iustitia* have their dignities in the *Hard signs* Aries Gemini Virgo Scorpio Capricorn and Aquarius
- 229 and in the Soft signs Taurus Cancer Leo Libra Sagittarius and Pisces their debilites. ¹⁹⁸¹



First domicile


230 The *first domicile* is arranged according to the orbital circumference of the planets. ¹⁹⁷⁹

Except for the Lights of Life (the moon orbits the earth and the sun orbits the Galactic Centre), all planets orbit the sun.

231 The series begins with Cancer (the C has the smallest orbit) and winds up through the active signs to Capricorn; from Aquarius, it descends through the passive signs to Leo (the \bigcirc has the largest orbit). 1979



- 243 If we take the exaltations as a *third domicile*, the *Lights of Life* are not reflected. They stop in their *first domicile*. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 244 Then the \odot has its *first* and *second domicile* in the Ω and the C has its *first* and *second dom-icile* in the \Im .¹⁹⁷⁴

Also with Mercury we find a double dignity in one sign (second domicile and exaltation in the \mathbb{W}) etc.



Second domicile

- 245 From this it could be concluded that the exaltations are about the third dignity (third domicile). 1974
- 246 This asymmetry can only be justified by the fact that all planets each have a *double dignity* in one sign. ¹⁹⁷⁴

Basic rules of the dignities

- 247 Thus it stands to reason that the twelve planets in each sign of the zodiac have a dignity or a weakness. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 248 All planets have seven dignities and seven debilities. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 249 No planet can have both a dignity and a weakness in one sign. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 250 Planets opposing each other in the dignities (e.g. $Q \simeq \sigma' Y$), cannot have a dignity in any sign in which its opponent or its *twin planet* has a dignity.¹⁹⁷⁴
- 251 Planets opposing each other in the dignities (e.g. 4*A Ψ*Π) cannot have a dignity in *twin* signs (e.g. 4𝔅 𝔅𝔅). ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 252 Soft planets have their dignities in Soft signs and their debilities in Hard ones. ¹⁹⁸²
- 253 Hard planets have their dignities in Hard signs and their dignities in Soft ones. ¹⁹⁸²
- 254 Twin planets are always reflected around the axis of dignities in the twin signs. ¹⁹⁷⁴
 So if a planet (e.g. 4) has a dignity (e.g. 3rd domicile) in a sign (e.g. 3) then its twin planet (Ψ) has the same dignity (3rd domicile) in the corresponding twin sign (Ω)...
- 255 The rules for all dignities can be derived from the first and second domiciles. ¹⁹⁸²

Exaltations (3rd Domicile)

256 With the exception of the *Lights of Life* (\bigcirc/C) , the active planets are exalted in passive signs *(third domicile)* and the passive planets in active ones. ¹⁹⁷⁴

Example: the active σ in the passive $\overline{\sigma}$ and the active $\overline{4}$ in the passive $\overline{\Im}$ etc.

Only with the *Lights of Life* is it the other way round: the passive C in the passive \Im .

- 257 As with the *first* and *second domiciles*, the exaltations are also in *twin signs*. *twin planets* are each in *twin signs*. ¹⁹⁸¹
- 258 Ψ , the counterpart of 4, is therefore exalted in the Ω . ¹⁹⁸¹
- 259 ¥, the counterpart of σ is therefore exalted in the \Im .¹⁹⁸¹
- 260 \forall , the counterpart of \bigcirc is therefore exalted in the \mathbb{A} .¹⁹⁸¹
- 261 5, the counterpart of \mathfrak{P} is therefore exalted in the \mathbb{II} . ¹⁹⁸¹
- 262 The *Lights of Life* \bigcirc and \bigcirc are exalted in the \bigcirc signs (\circlearrowright and \cong [\curlyvee]). ¹⁹⁷⁶
- 263 The *Causal Forces* δ and δ are exalted in the σ signs ($\forall [\cong]$ and \mathbb{T}). ¹⁹⁷⁶
- 264 It turns out that the Chaldeans mistakenly or intentionally interchanged the exaltation signs of \odot and 5. ¹⁹⁷⁶

For the Chaldeans, the \simeq was a perfect and sacred place for the \bigcirc . ²⁰⁰²

But they also believed that the positions of \odot and 5 (opposite sun, black sun, star of the sun) were interchangeable. ¹⁹⁷⁶

Degrees of exaltation

- 265 The degrees of exaltation were not derived from past planetary or stellar positions, as has been repeatedly assumed but never proven. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 266 They were determined using the golden section (ϕ). ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 267 The starting point is $\sqrt{360} = 18.973666 (18^{\circ} 58' 25.2'')$. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 268 The division of the zodiac into ten 36° sections, divided by the golden ratio, is the most reasonable explanation for the degrees of exaltation we have to date. ¹⁹⁷⁴

The surviving degrees of exaltation of \odot , C, Q, d' and 4 are on these axes.

 \heartsuit and 5 are only 2° off.

Three axes fall in each of the female signs of the zodiac and two in the male. ¹⁹⁷⁴

269 With this knowledge, we can now also determine the degrees of exaltation of \mathfrak{F} , \mathfrak{P} and Υ and even those of Υ and \mathfrak{F} . ¹⁹⁸¹

- 284 *Eros planets* are on the right side (\nearrow to \times). ¹⁹⁸¹
- 285 Distance of the *twins* $\forall/5, \forall/4, \forall/4, \forall = 94^{\circ} 15' = (58^{\circ} 15' \times 1,618034 (\phi)).$ ¹⁹⁸¹
- 286 Distance of opponents $\forall/4, \forall/5, \forall/5, \forall/4 = 58^{\circ} 15' = (94^{\circ} 15' / 1,618034 (\phi)).$ ¹⁹⁸¹
- 287 \forall/ φ occupy two of the three \forall / \Re axes. Distance = 13° 45' = (36° / 2,618034 (ϕ))¹⁹⁷⁴
- 288 $\frac{1}{3}$ occupy two of the three $\frac{5}{3}$ axes. Distance = $13^{\circ} 45^{\prime}$
- 289 Ψ/Υ occupy the two Ω/\Im axes. Distance = 13° 45' ¹⁹⁸¹
- 290 $\forall/5$ occupy the two Π/\mathcal{A} axes. Distance = $13^{\circ} 45'^{1981}$
- 291 The symmetry suggests that the C is at 16° ♂ (classical 3° ♂, Indian 3° ∨ 23°), 5 is at 19° ∨ (classical 21° ≏, Indian 20° ≃), 5 is at 25° ℝ and the ⊙ is at 10° ≏ (classical 19° ∨, Indian 10° ∨). ¹⁹⁸¹

In fact, I've long suspected that Uranus might be exalted in Aries and Saturn in Scorpio. This would explain things better. See theses 256 and 297.

- 292 Three axes (every fifth) are not occupied. It is always the first axis that falls in a female sign.
- 293 Presumably, the degrees of exaltation has no astrological significance. It seems that they are more of a mathematical gimmick. ¹⁹⁸¹

Even after thousands of years, there are no tenable theories or ideas for practically applying these degrees. ¹⁹⁸¹

They stand meaningless in (astrological) space. ¹⁹⁸¹

Trigonocracy

- 294 The dignity of trigonocracy (triplicity) is false. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 295 It is in contradiction with the exaltations. ¹⁹⁷⁴
 - C/\mathbb{T} , Q/\mathbb{T} and $\mathfrak{C}/\mathfrak{S}$ = trigonocracy (dignity) and fall (debility).

This seems to be an inconsistent attempt to expand or complete the system of dignities and debilities. ¹⁹⁷⁴

If we include the dignities found from the variants 1-5, the same is true for the following planets: \bigcirc/\curlyvee , $5/\cong$, δ/\circlearrowright , Υ/Ω and $\Upsilon/\amalg =$ dignity (trigonocracy) and debility [case].¹⁹⁸¹

Other dignities

You can find detailed descriptions in the book "APOKATASTASIS".

296 As with the *first* and *second domiciles*, the planets mirror each other across the *dignity axis* from the *third* to the *fourth dignity*. ¹⁹⁸¹

Example: the σ is reflected from the $\gtrsim (3^{rd} dignity)$ into the $\approx (4^{th} dignity)$ etc.

297 The thesis 256 can also be applied to the third change (from the $5^{th} [6^{th}]$ to the $6^{th} [7^{th}]$ dignity). ¹⁹⁸¹

Example: the active σ first in the passive \mathbb{T} and then in the active \mathbb{I} .

Except for the *Lights of Life*: the active \bigcirc first in the active \nearrow and then in the passive \cong and the passive \boxtimes and the passive \boxtimes and then in the active \nearrow .

313 This means there are four *complete dignity systems to* choose from out of myriads of possibilities (after all, only!). ²⁰¹⁹

The basic rules of the dignities (theses 247-250) apply to all four variants. ²⁰¹⁹

314 The classical and modern domiciles [and exaltations] and exiles [and fall] cannot be explained more simply, logically and symmetrically. ²⁰¹⁹

The exaltations speak in favour of variants 1 [and 2]. 1981/1995



The symmetry speaks for variants 3 and 4. 2019

Another indication for variants 3 and 4 is that the same opponents always face each other in all dignities. ²⁰¹⁹

However, it is unusual that the \odot has its 2^{nd} domicile in the \Im and the C in the Ω .

Variants 3 and 4 are equally symmetrical and logical. ²⁰²²

To date, I have not found any argument that speaks more for or against the 3rd or the 4th variant and I suspect that none can be found either. ²⁰²²

Which of these four systems is the right one? I cannot judge conclusively. 2022

- 317 A precise definition of all dignities and debilities is therefore not possible at the moment. ²⁰²²
- 318 I consider the *first domicile* and *exile* of all twelve planets to be secure. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 319 The 2^{nd} domicile and exile of the planets $\forall/\forall/\forall/\forall/\forall/\forall/\forall/\forall/\forall'$ supports the tradition. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 320 The remaining assignments could be treated as *tertiary dignities* and *debilities*. ²⁰²²
- 321 This would allow uncomplicated, practical application and be in line with all four variants and the *basic rules of the dignities (theses 247-250).*²⁰²²

322 It would be radical if we only allowed the 1st domicile and exile to apply. ²⁰²²

o', for example, would have been the sole ruler of \forall and would never have had a domicile in \mathbb{N} . In contrast, its twin principle, Υ , would always have ruled the \mathbb{N} alone. ²⁰²²

In view of the strong fixation of astrologers on what they have learned, such considerations are not absurd. $^{\rm 2022}$

323 The planets would be "relatives" in the signs of the same *clan* (*Soft* or *Hard*) and "strangers" in the signs of the opposing clan. ²⁰²²



Critical thoughts

- 324 Self-fulfilling prophecies and the dear Barnum Effect all too often leads, astrologers and their clients by the nose must not be ignored. ¹⁹⁷⁷
- 325 To err is human. That was the case in the past and it is the case today and it is also true for astrologers. Therefore, no astrological theory should be untouchable. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 326 The "criminally neglected basic research" by astrologers must be advanced. Astrology is not a finished product. ²⁰⁰²

Greek-Egyptian explorers in Alexandria (about 300 to 150 BC) were instrumental in shaping modern astrology, but uprisings and riots eventually prevented further investigation.

327 As long as astrologers cannot explain "how" and "why" astrology works, this so-called "empirical science" cannot be proven statistically either. ¹⁹⁹⁵

Thanks to Gauquelin, one had such supposed but hardly noticed "proof" for years.

328 Mythology must not be transferred one-to-one to astrology. ¹⁹⁷⁸

Logically, there is a great deal of agreement between mythological and astrological characters, but much mythology is pure poetry and contradictory in itself. Moreover, the mythological meanings of the planetary gods sometimes differ greatly between different cultures. For example, Saturn (Romans), Kronos (Greeks), Ninurta (Sumerians), Shani (Indians) or Mars (Romans), Ares (Greeks), Nergal (Sumerians), Mangala (Indians) etc. ¹⁹⁷⁸

329 Naming the duality male-female is misleading. ¹⁹⁷⁴

It is an outdated patriarchal prejudice that the male is extroverted, creative and active and the female is passive, weak and introverted. ¹⁹⁷⁴

- 330 The transfer of the four classical elements, fire, earth, air and water, to the zodiac signs is probably wrong and based on a visual misjudgment. ¹⁹⁷⁴
- 331 The equilateral triangle is nice to look at, but more apt (more similar in essence) to each other are connected (in isosceles triangles): ¹⁹⁷⁶
- 332 $\Im/C \Im/\Upsilon \varkappa/\Psi = Moist Terrible^{1976}$
- 333 $\boxed{3}/5 \boxed{1}/4 \boxed{7}/5 = Dry Barren^{1976}$
- 334 $\left[\Omega / \bigcirc \Im / \bigcirc \swarrow / \bigcirc \varkappa / \bigcirc + \swarrow \right] = \text{Warm} \text{Growth-promoting}^{1976}$
- 335 $\boxed{m} / \delta \forall / \delta' \Pi / \forall = \text{Cold} \text{Growth retardant}^{1976}$

The ancients (terrible-barren as well as benefactor-offenders) already rudimentarily knew these groupings. ¹⁹⁷⁴

336 I question the division into mutable (unstable, dispersed, mobile, dissolving), fixed (solid) and cardinal signs. ¹⁹⁷⁴

Not only have astrologers always struggled with a uniform naming of this grouping, but the description of the three groups contradicts the character of some signs. The "cardinal" characteristics apply well to the sign \vee but hardly to the signs \cong and \Im . The introverted, sensitive, quickly receding and maternal \Im should suddenly mutate into a dynamic, energetic and assertive sign. ¹⁹⁷⁴

337 The division into personal [○C♀♀♂], societal (social) [45] and spiritual (collective, invisible, transpersonal) [♂Ψ♀] planets is not comprehensible. ¹⁹⁹⁵

 δ invisible!? Υ spiritual!? Υ trade = personal? Υ die = collective? etc. ¹⁹⁹⁵

338 The housing problem remains unsolved. ²⁰⁰⁶

House systems must be questioned if they do not project house cusps and planets over the same poles on the ecliptic (latitudinal error). ²⁰⁰⁶

339 The three great circles of the place of reference (human being, event) intersect the ecliptic at six points and thus couple the astrological constellation with the human being. They are the connecting links between man (event) and the zodiac.

Horizon (above/below)	= Ascendant (East) –	Descendant (West)
Meridian (East/West)	= Medium Coeli [South] -	Imum Coeli [North]
1 st Vertical (South/North)	= Upper Vertex (top) –	Lower Vertex (bottom)

Are they "only" sensitive points, or do they "also" relate to the houses?

340 The practice has shown that it is also possible to work "successfully" with speculative, imaginative effect points (the Barnum Effect sends its regards). ¹⁹⁹⁵

Such as the Vanilla planets; the Trans-Neptunian $(2 \oplus 2 \oplus 1 \oplus 4)$; the (Trans-pluto/Isis); the self-contradictory Monomoiria (Sepharial, Charubel, Sabian symbols etc.); "any" direction keys (instead of $1^\circ = 1$ year, take $3.7^\circ = 1$ year or $5.6^\circ = 1$ year etc.). There are no limits to the imagination.

341 In view of this, we should also critically question other theories! ¹⁹⁸²

Chiron; Lilith, of which there are several; the lunar nodes (Ω/ϑ) , which are sporadically interpreted differently; the sensitive points, of which new ones are invented again and again; the various antiscion systems; the division of the zodiac into 24, 36, 72, 108, 144 or 360 sections; the various contradictory terms; the various sidereal zodiacs; the many house systems etc. etc.

- 342 Do you really have to "blindly believe everything", even if it "apparently" works; if it is contradictory and illogical; only because there are a lot of talks or writing about it; because it is from old traditions or comes from astrological luminaries?
- 343 Important questions:

How can the rationally speaking absurd equations between a strological constellations and life on earth be explained? $^{\rm 1974}$

Are there causal connections between astrological constellations and the events at their Centre, or do we need other explanatory models?¹⁹⁷⁶

Is there also functioning astrology outside of biospheres? So if life had never arisen on earth, would astrological constellations also mirror physical and causal processes? ²⁰¹⁶

Here I tend to say no. I suspect that astrology is a phenomenon that only shows itself in *bio-* and *physical spheres*, i.e., at the interfaces between the *physical* and the *vital universe*. ²⁰²²

How does the astrological reflection show up in life forms that have left their ancestral biosphere? Like, for example, the 24 astronauts who flew to the moon or in possible future space missions to other planets or solar systems. ²⁰¹⁶
